

Disaster Prevention and Relief

The functional category of “Disaster Prevention and Relief” includes grant programs that prepare for, prevent, mitigate, and respond to natural disasters like wildfire, earthquakes, and flooding, as well as terrorism, hazardous releases, and other disasters.
